It's now official we are a good school...

As you know two weeks ago we had a visit from Her Majesty's School Inspectorate Ofsted. I am now delighted to be able to make their findings available to you.

The report tells us that the school has a vision that ***"all pupils will succeed"*** and that it provides ***"good quality education"*** enabling children to make ***"good progress"***. It tells us that your children are proud of their school; they believe it is ***"a place to shine"***. The children talked confidently about how the school encourages ***"kindness, team work, courage and persistence"***. Ofsted praised how the school prepares children ***"for their place in the world"*** by being ***"highly inclusive"***. The inspector recognised our ***"commitment to developing the 'whole child'"***

Children told the inspector that they ***"feel safe in school"*** and she spoke of the ***"strong safeguarding culture in school"*** She told us that all staff are ***"vigilant to safeguarding issues, no matter how small"***

The report recognises how ***"tirelessly"*** the whole team works to continue to improve the school. The inspector recognised how teachers know their children well and make ***"good use of information about children's progress to identify pupils who have fallen behind and provide them with appropriate support"***.

There are obviously points for us to work on, and work on them we will.
